GENERAL CLEANLINESS WHILE BABYSITTING

Babysitters are hired to take care of the children they're responsible for. Cleaning is a part of doing a good job. A good babysitter will tidy up any messes that were made while caring for the children.

- If you prepare any food for the children, clean up any dishes, or pots and pans that may have been used. Wipe down counters and eating area too.
- Wash your hands before and after preparing food for the children.
- If making crafts, put crafting supplies away once done, and tidy the area used.
- Help children clean up the toys they are done playing with before moving onto the next activity.
- Clean up any spills that occur while you are there.
- If you are watching a baby, cleaning up will include changing and disposing of diapers, and cleaning out bottles.

Talk to parents before they leave, and make yourself some notes to help you remember your responsibilities while being a good babysitter.

If you don't feel well, it is "ok" to call in sick. Parents would prefer that you let them know and cancel. You don't want to risk getting the kids sick.
