SAFE AT HOME, SAFE ALONE DOOR SAFETY


You will need to know your house rule if someone comes to your door. When you are home alone it is important to plan ahead of time what to do, so in the moment you don't panic.

Some house rules may be:

Look out the window or peep hole to see who is at the door and only let in people on your house rules list.



Don't go to the door at all when you are home alone.



Rules about door safety:

- Always keep your doors locked.
- Never say you are home alone.
- Know what you would say if someone asks for your family.
- Never let a stranger inside, even in the case of emergency.
- Adults should not ask kids for help, do not answer the door!
- If a stranger is persistent and will not leave, call for help.
- Remember your safety comes first!

Your household may want to create a "code word." This is a secret word between you and your family. If someone does say they know your family, he or she must prove it by saying the family code word.
